



## GENERAL GYM / GYMSTAR DEVELOPMENT INFORMATION & TIMETABLE

Thank you for your interest in our programs. The best place for school aged children to start at Eclipse is in our General Gym or Gymstar Development program. Children of all abilities are welcome at Eclipse so please let us know if your child has special needs so that we can ensure the best possible gymnastics class for them.

### What is the General Gym program?

General Gym is a one hour per week class for boys and girls aged 5-11 years which incorporates a variety of gym sports including artistic gymnastics, rhythmic gymnastics, trampolining and acrobatics. General gym gives a solid base of skills and physical preparation to move through the Eclipse programs and will enhance any sport in which your child participates.

### What is the Gymstar Development program?

Gymstar Development is a two hour per week class for boys and girls aged 11-14 years which incorporates a variety of gym sports including artistic gymnastics, rhythmic gymnastics, trampolining and acrobatics. Gymnasts will consolidate basic gymnastic skills and progress on to more advanced skills as they are ready to do so.

This program leads into the Gymstar competition program where gymnasts have the opportunity to learn routines and enter competitions against other clubs if they wish to do so. Gymstar development is recommended for gymnasts aged 11-14 years who want to improve and further develop their skills and physical abilities either to achieve personal goals or to prepare for competitions the following year.

### 2020 DATES

Classes commence on January 28th and run through to December 19th. All classes run as normal during the April, June and September/October school holidays. Classes do not run on public holidays and are not charged for. There are no refunds or credits for missed classes but make up classes can be done anytime during the year.

### TUITION FEES

Fees are paid in advance via monthly direct debit on the 15th of every month from January to November. Fees are calculated based on the number of classes from the date of your first class until the end of the year (December 21st).

Your first class is paid for as a casual session and if you are happy to continue, there will be an up front payment to be made by your next class and your direct debit payments will start on the 15th of the following month. You can cancel anytime with 14 days written notification. Please see attached fees policy.

### ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEES

There is an annual registration fee to be paid which is inclusive of club registration covering certificates, club T-shirt, equipment maintenance and administration, and Gymnastics Victoria registration which includes accident insurance. Registration fees expire at the end of December and are prorated each month. This fee is due by your child's second class.

### BOOKING PROCEDURE

Please choose the day that suits you best and either email or phone us and we will organise the booking for you. We will then email you a confirmation of your booking along with some further information regarding the classes.

2020 classes will commence on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 28th** (with the last class for 2020 being Saturday, December 19th)

- All classes will run as normal through the April, June and September holidays making a total of 47 weeks of classes less public holidays.
- Classes do not run on public holidays and are not charged for.
- Your monthly payment will be reduced in a month where a public holiday falls on the day of your child's class.
- Monthly payments will be debited from your credit card on the 15th of the month from January to November inclusive.
- You can choose to pay your annual fees in full and receive a 5% discount. See reception staff if you wish to do this.
- There are family discounts so please see reception staff if you are enrolling more than one child.



## **ECLIPSE GYMNASTICS FEES POLICY 2020**

By enrolling your child at Eclipse Gymnastics you agree to the following terms and conditions:

### **Tuition fees:**

- Tuition fees pay for your gymnast's place in the class.
- Tuition fees are calculated on the number of classes from the date of your first class until the end of the calendar year and then paid via monthly direct debits on the 15th of each month.

### **Registration fee:**

- The registration fee is paid separately to the tuition fees.
- This fee is inclusive of club registration which covers certificates, club T-shirt, equipment maintenance and administration, and Gymnastics Victoria registration which includes accident insurance. Please note that the registration fee is non refundable once the gymnast has been registered with Gymnastics Victoria.

### **Direct debit information:**

- All tuition fees will be charged to your credit or debit card via a direct debit payment on the 15th of each month.
- The first payment will be January 15th with the final payment for the year being November 15th.
- If you start part way through the year there will be an upfront payment initially to catch up to the direct debit cycle and your monthly payments will commence on the 15th of the month after your starting date.
- If you prefer to pay eftpos or cash, you can do so in person prior to the 15th of each month, however, we still require a credit card to be kept on file and payment will be charged to that card if the instalment is not paid prior to the 15th.
- Classes do not run on public holidays and are not charged for.
- Any classes cancelled by Eclipse Gymnastics for any reason will not be charged for.
- Annual registration fees must be paid separately to secure your child's place.
- Should a payment be declined, you will be notified immediately with a re-scheduled date. There will be a \$10.00 charge added to your payment should it be declined a second time.

### **Paying annual fees up front:**

- You can pay your total annual fees up front and receive a 5% discount.
- Fees must be paid in full **prior to the first direct** debit date to receive the 5% discount.

### **Security:**

To ensure the safety of your information, your credit card details will be encrypted in our FileMaker database, and we will be purchasing security certificates to further encrypt and secure the information as it is transferred to our 3rd party Merchant service company, Merchant Warrior, who is a PCI DSS (Payment Card Industry & Data Security Standard) compliant company.

### **Cancellation procedure:**

Should you wish to cancel your gymnast's booking at any time you must provide 14 days written notification. Once we have received notification we will email you with your final direct debit date or to let you know of any refunds owing. If you have paid your fees in full you will receive a refund for the remaining classes for the year. You should not consider your cancellation finalised until you have received written confirmation from Eclipse Gymnastics acknowledging your withdrawal. Please note your 14 day cancellation period begins the day after we receive your written notification.

### **Refunds, credits and make up classes:**

- Eclipse Gymnastics does not offer refunds or credits for missed classes. Your tuition pays to hold your place in the class regardless of attendance, however, make up classes can be done at any time during the year.
- Make up classes must be booked in advance, must be done while the gymnast is a current member and within the same year as the missed class.
- If you book a make up class and then cannot attend, you must call prior to the day of the class to cancel the make up and you can then organise another one at a later stage. If you do not let us know that you can't attend your make up class at least the day before, you will forgo that class and cannot then re-book a make up for the original missed class.
