



2026 KINDERGYM CLASSES

What is the Kindergym program?

We offer two types of classes for children from 2 - 5 years of age. A parent participation program for 2-4 year olds which runs for 45 minutes and requires an adult to be involved in the class with the child. And an independent program for 3.5-5 year olds which runs for one hour and does not require an adult to be involved, however parents are encouraged to stay and watch their child's class.

Our Kindergym program combines games, music, group work and structured activities to develop the fundamentals of movement in a fun, positive and encouraging environment. The children will use all of the equipment including trampolines, beams, bars and foam pit. Our aim is to introduce the children to the fundamental body shapes and movement patterns used in gymnastic skills through a wide variety of themed movement activities. Children also learn skills such as safe landings, how to roll, swing, balance and take weight on their hands in preparation for handstands and cartwheels. We also focus on helping children learn how to interact in a positive manner with the instructor and other children in the class. The children can progress from Kindergym to our General Gym program when they start school.

Uniform requirements

There is no set uniform at this level, but children need to wear clothing suitable for gymnastics activities. Shorts/leggings and T-shirt, or a leotard is perfect. The class is done in bare feet. All gymnasts must bring a named drink bottle to class (water only).

Tuition fees

Fees are charged annually from your child's first class to their final class for the year, and are paid via monthly direct debit on the 15th of each month using your nominated credit card. Fees are paid slightly in advance, so there will be an initial upfront payment when you first start. You can set up your direct debit with our reception staff either in person or over the phone. Enrolments can be cancelled at any time with 14 days written notice.

Registration fees

The registration fees are paid per calendar year. Club registration covers certificates, club T-shirt, equipment maintenance and administration. Gymnastics Victoria registration includes accident insurance. Please note that registration fees are non refundable once the gymnast is registered with Gymnastics Victoria.

- All classes run as normal through the April, June and September holidays. The final classes for 2026 will be December 19th.
- Classes do not run on public holidays. Your monthly payment will be reduced where a public holiday falls on the day of your child's class.
- A 5% family discount is applied to tuition fees for each subsequent child enrolled from the same family.
- Make up classes are available and must be done within 10 weeks in the current year while the gymnast is a current member.
